### Scholarship Award Criteria

The selection criteria below are the specific standards that will be used to identify the successful applicants for these scholarships.

- A student enrolled in full time relevant Tertiary study or,
- An employee within the industry who aspires to improve their skills, knowledge and value to the employer with extra study.
- Pre course academic achievement, including grades, standardised test scores and achievement test scores.
- Expected career choice in specific industry activities.
- Work history, awards and recognition.
- Recommendation of Principal Tutor or employer.
- Community/extracurricular involvement.
- New Zealand Citizenship or Permanent Resident.
- Resident of Tairāwhiti Region.

**NB.** *If no applicants should match the criteria or eligibility, Eastland Wood Council will ascertain if the scholarship is awarded in that year or if the criteria can be extended to include other applicants.*
